A. IB Diploma Results

Of the 65 students who took the IB Diploma examinations:

14 scored 40 or more points

38 scored 35 or more points

54 scored 30 or more points

The world average score of all IB Diploma students this summer was 29.8 points; the CSS average score was 35.3 points.

55.6% of CSS students achieved the bilingual Diploma.

B. Hong Kong Diploma Results

Of the 21 students who took the HKDSE examinations: For the 4 core subjects: 1 scored an average of 5 or more points 7 scored an average of 4 or more points

For elective subjects:

1 scored an average of 5 or more points

6 scored an average of 4 or more points

12 scored an average of 3 or more points

48% of students scored a grade 5 in at least one of their subjects
